### 3. Festival: Bend Beer Fest

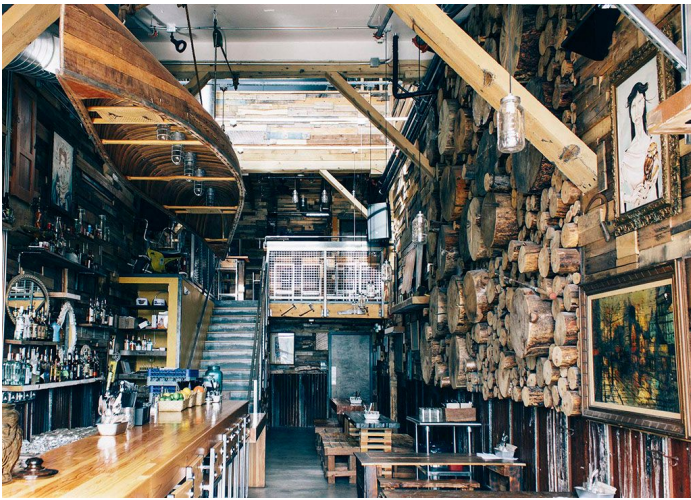
